She has also represented the USA on several world teams, winning medals and honors.

Stacy's training philosophy is building based on а strong relationship with each dog, understanding their individual needs and motivations, and using positive reinforcement and clear communication achieve to success. She believes that agility is not only a fun and challenging sport, but also a way to enhance the bond between dogs and their owners. She is always eager to learn new skills and techniques, and to adapt to the changing trends and challenges of the sport.
